







Conclusion

From the above queries and all the execution, we have understood the following points:

- The crimes that were reported in Chicago was a total of 82,088 in just one year, 2021. Chicago is a hub for multiple sorts of crimes out of which burglary, homicide, and assaults were the highest committed ones.
- The high-risk community is seen as Austin whereas the highest-risk street is Michigan Ave. Due to this, we can conclude that people should stop choosing these two areas as a place to live and police vigilance should be increased to try and avoid future crimes. Security cameras and other safety measures also could be improved and added.
- The month of January shows the highest number of crimes reported, which we can also conclude by saying the weather is not causing any effect on the rate of crimes reported.
